- Motif of this kilim is inspired by traditional Bosnian kilims, (first half of the XX century) from the ethnology collection of the Bosniac Institute that consists of over 1000 objects
- It was donated to the Bosniac Institute by Kanita Mirsada Hodžić in 2001.
- The souvenir is produced by the **Bhcrafts**, an enterprise which unites creative humanitarian female business and personal development elements in a balanced and successful manner. Cases for smart devices or/and other trinkets



2nd place

Cases for small devices or/and other trinkets

- made in traditional handmade two string knitting technique
- made of pure domestic wool in colors that are most often present on the socks in the museum collection.
- Specific vegetative and anthropomorphic ornaments and motives from socks are reproduced on souvenirs.
- the most significant elements of traditional domestic textile production in Knjazevac area.
- Old technique was brought by Old Slavic tribes to the Balkans.
- Intangible heritage of Eastern Serbia: oral heritage and knowledge about the technique, symbolic meaning of motives and colors
